## ITEMS TO BRING TO SCHOOL

## P1 – P7, LSC and ASC All Pupils

Nursery Arrangements will be communicated separately

What to bring to school each day: (child's name must be clearly labelled on each item)

A bottle of water (to be brought home each day for thorough cleaning and refilling)

A healthy lunch (a lunch box/bag which can and must be cleaned every day and is small - not a school bag)

A rain jacket with a hood

P3 – P7 may also bring fruit for break.

## What you must not bring to school:

A school bag: Any toys or personal items

# First Day of Return

Each Key stage requires additional items which are to be brought into school on the first day of return and will remain in school - these are listed below. Nursery and LSC/ASC arrangements will be communicated separately to parents.

### P1 and P2

## A small bottle of hand sanitiser

A small zip wallet (A5) or pencil case containing: Twistable Colouring pencils – can be bought in home bargains for 99p, Crayola markers, Glue stick.

Box of pop up tissues, Packet of wipes (sensitive if possible), Antibacterial soap (sensitive if possible)

£10 snack money in a sealed and labelled envelope – exact amount please.

### P3.P3/4 and P4

A small bottle of hand sanitiser, individual packs of tissues, sanitising wipes. A small zip wallet (A5) or pencil case containing: a pencil sharpener, glue stick, packet of crayons/twistables and a 15cm ruler.

#### P5 - P7

A small bottle of hand sanitiser, individual packs of tissues, sanitising wipes. A small zip wallet (A5) or pencil case containing: a pencil sharpener, glue stick, twistables/ colouring pencils/crayons and a 15cm ruler.

ALL WALLETS/PENCIL CASES AND HAND SANITISER BOTTLES TO BE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH CHILD'S NAME.

Medicines/Inhalers etc must be sent into school in a clear lunchbox, with the child's name. All parents whose child has any form of medicine/prescription to be administered in school must complete a Medication form before medicines can be given.
